- We're intending to run an Enquirer's Course for anyone interested in finding out more about faith in the New Year. 'Treasure in the Field' will be held from 7 8.30pm on five Monday evenings from January 13th and will include a simple meal each time. Experience shows that there's nothing like a personal invitation, so if you know anyone who might perhaps be on the edges of the Church and interested in finding out more about Christian life, do pass the details on and encourage them to contact James.
- **The Church Office** is not being staffed this coming week. James is on leave from Monday 30th to Friday 3rd.
- There will be a short **Vestry Meeting** after the 10am service to elect a churchwarden to serve the remainder of the year 2024-2025.
- The PCC voted (by email) this week to support the application of Farncombe Infants School to join the Learning Partners Church Academy Trust. In some ways we would like our parish school to remain independent, but this is increasingly unfeasible for small infant schools given the management pressures and demands for special needs provision, and the ongoing expectation by Government that all schools will eventually move to academy status. Positively, academisation gives the school access to more resources and wider expertise, and smooths the current connection with Loseley Fields School which is also a member of LPCAT. There will continue to be a local governing body including the Rector and two Foundation Governors nominated by the PCC, and the Rector and Churchwardens remain the legal owners of the school site.
